* It appears that Arthur and Nancy accompanied each other to New Hampshire where they were immediately married. They resided there for a few years and relocated to Quebec. Nancy, apparently estranged him and is said to have lived in a New York Indian village for a while (which explains her presence at St. Regis in the 1880's) however, she did return. Not much is known of Arthur Norris Batchelder, except he was a logger and an Indian from Maine. Nancy was raised primarily by her grandmother Marie Helen Otonosen in Durham, PQ. For unknown reason Nancy's parents returned to Joseph Snow's in Ontario in an Iroquois Indian village. No apparent contact after this point.

* Family Bible indicates Joseph's parents as Charles and Angela. Marie-Helen housed granddaughter Nancy during adolescence. Resided in Durham at that time and before. Relocated to New York in 'Golden Years' and died there. Brother ~~is~~ was Chief.
